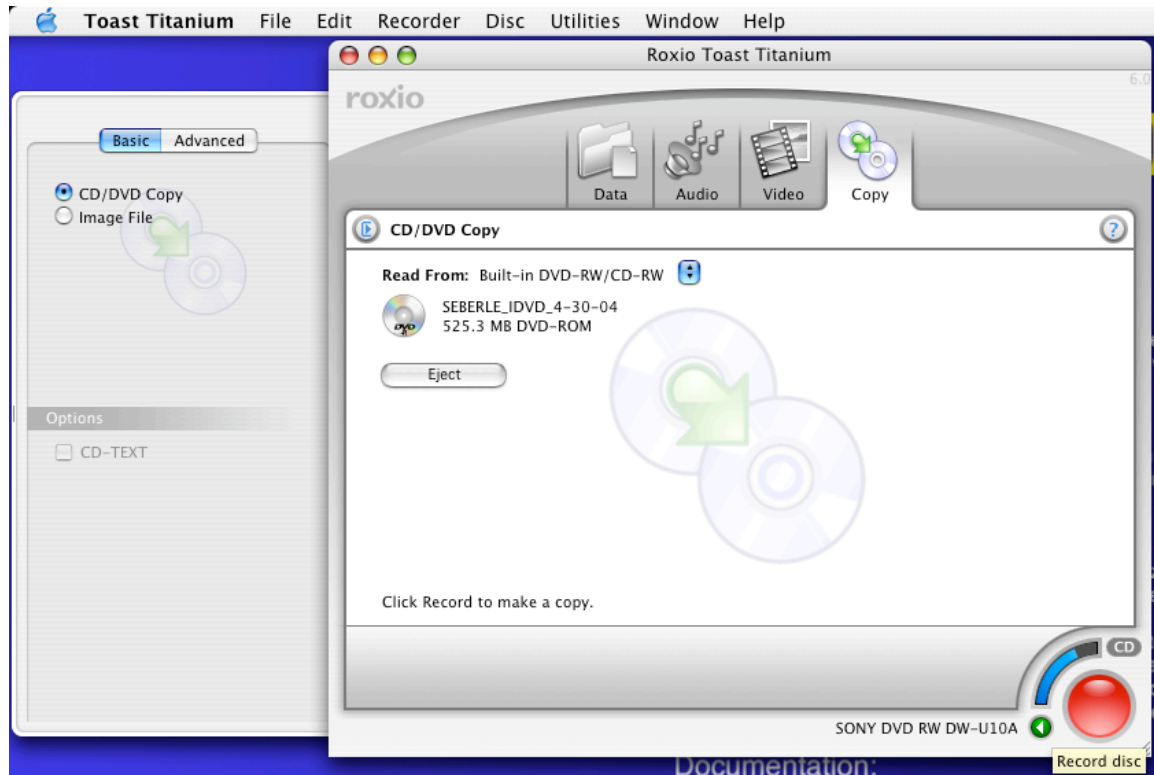


Duplicating A DVD On Macintosh Computer With Toast

The purpose of this document is to guide users in duplicating a DVD by using the Toast Titanium application, which can be found on all DVD/CDROM burning Digital Media Commons, supported computers.

When duplicating a DVD, there are several hidden files that must be copied along with VIDEO_TS and AUDIO_TS folders. Simply dragging these folders into a disc copying/creation application will not allow the new DVD to simply play or even operate on another DVD player or computer. A user must actually duplicate the entire disc.



1. Open the Toast Titanium application.
2. Select Copy from options at the top of the application window.
3. Insert the DVD to be copied into the computer.
4. Make sure "CD/DVD Copy" is selected.
5. Click the red "Record Disc" button
6. Follow directions. Toast will copy the contents of the DVD to the hard drive and ask that the blank DVD be inserted. Toast will then copy the data to the blank DVD and analyze for errors. If working with a computer with two drives, a DVD-Rom and DVD-Writer, insert the disc to be copied in the Rom and the blank into the DVD Writer. The process will be quite a bit faster since it will be copying from one disc right to the other.
